The Japanese Cultural and Community Center of Northern California (JCCCNC) located in San Francisco's Japantown is the largest Japanese America community-owned facility in Northern California serving over 185,000 people a year. Founded in 1973, the JCCCNC is an everlasting foundation of our Japanese American ancestry, cultural heritage, histories and traditions.

The JCCCNC organized the Japantown History Walk Project as a permanent educational public display featuring historical and culturally significant landmarks in the community. It is part of their effort to preserve our community and past for future generations to learn from and enjoy.
