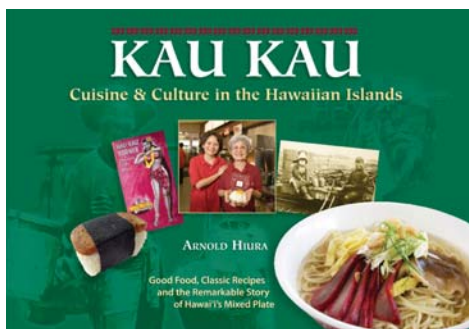


Taste Hawai'i Tour
