With a history of over 50 years, the Sapporo Yuki Matsuri boasts nearly 300 ice and snow sculptures for only seven days. The Festival has grown and now hosts over two million visitors each year.



Other highlights of the tour include sampling some of the regions freshest seafood (salmon teppan-yaki and crab nabe), other dining specialties (ramen) and a one-night stay at a **world class onsen - Ryokan Suizatei** where participants will enjoy a wonderful winter kaiseki meal.
