

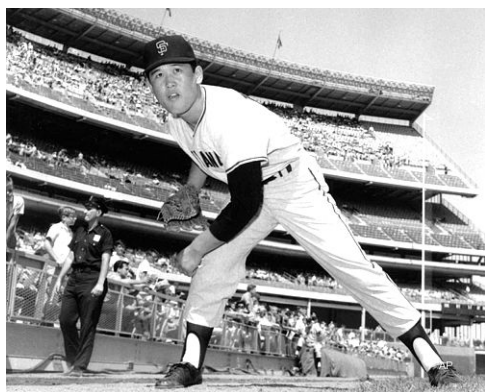

San Francisco (May 6, 2014) – Join the Japanese Cultural and Community Center of Northern California (JCCCNC) on Thursday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:15 p.m. to cheer on the San Francisco Giants as they play the Miami Marlins. The Giants will be celebrating Japanese Heritage Night honoring the 50th anniversary of Masanori “Mashi” Murakami’s breakthrough entry into the Major Leagues as the first Japanese-born player.



A ticket purchased through the JCCCNC includes a seat in the designated JCCCNC section (View Reserve 317, 318, and 319), a collectible Masanori Murakami commemorative “Bust,” and admission into the pre-game Japanese Heritage Night festival in Seals Plaza.
